1. Purpose

- 1.2. The purpose of this procedure is to describe the process for handling requests for meeting minutes and redaction of those minutes.

- 3. Responsibilities and Authorities
 - 3.1. Biological Safety Officer
 - 3.1.1. May receive requests for meeting minutes;
 - 3.1.2. Sends request to General Counsel and notifies IBC Chair;
 - 3.1.3. Processes, redacts and sends copies of the minutes to General Counsel.
 - 3.2. IBC Chair
 - 3.2.1. May receive requests for meeting minutes;
 - 3.2.2. Sends request to General Counsel and notifies BSO;
 - 3.2.3. May assist with redaction.
 - 3.3. General Counsel
 - 3.3.1. Follows University Policy 06.04;
 - 3.3.2. May assist with redaction.
 - 3.3.3. Sends copies of minutes to requestor.

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- 4. Items Needed
 - 4.1. Monthly IBC minutes
- 5. Procedure
 - 5.1. Any request from the public for copies of IBC minutes are forwarded to General Counsel as per University policy 06.04 Public Records Request Procedures;
 - 5.2. Criteria for Redaction
 - 5.2.1. Information that compromises the safety and security of MSU personnel, research and/or intellectual property, the institution or the nation will be redacted. Examples include but are not limited to:
 - 5.2.1.1. trade secret information;
 - 5.2.1.2. other confidential or proprietary commercial information;
 - 5.2.1.3. personal information about IBC members (home telephone numbers, home address);
 - 5.2.1.4. locations of laboratories, animal facilities and offices;
 - 5.2.1.5. location of biohazardous materials;
 - 5.2.1.6. personal information about the PI;
 - 5.2.1.7. specific details regarding animal experimentation including the names of PIs performing animal research;
 - 5.2.1.8. Pls under investigation for possible noncompliance;
 - 5.2.1.9. specific information whose disclosure would compromise institutional or national security.
